Objectives (TSW):

- Play an "EZ" G chord on guitar, strumming on quarter notes with 90% accuracy
- Play an "EZ" C chord on guitar with quarter notes with 90% accuracy.
- Accompany "Row, Row Your Boat" with the EZ C chord, strumming on quarter notes.
- Play the tab song, "Hot Cross Buns" with 80% accuracy.

Prior Knowledge and Experiences:

Opening:

TTW: Review "EZ G" chord, strings, frets, finger numbers, and hand position on guitar.

Procedures:

Chords:

- 1. TTW: Review the parts of the guitar
- 2. TTW: Have S echo T's strumming patterns on muted strings
- 3. TSW: Play strumming patterns on EZ G chord.
- 4. TTW: Have S accompany "Brother John" on guitar on the EZ G chord. while singing.
- 5. TTW: Introduce the EZ C chord.
- 6. TSW: S practice forming the EZ C chord on guitar. While T monitors and corrects.
- 7. TTW: Have S echo strumming patterns on the EZ C chord on guitar.
- 8. TTW: Have S turn to p. 15 and play the C chord.
- 9. TSW: Sing "Row, Row, Row Your Boat" and accompany on Guitar using the EZ C chord.

<u>Tablature:</u>

- 7. TTW: introduce tablature
- 8. TTW: Show Tab ppt.

- 9. TTW: Have S practice finding notes on the guitar using tab
- 10.TTW: Have S read and play the first three notes of "Hot Cross Buns" on guitar using tab.
- 11.TTW: Have S practice all of "Hot Cross Buns" on guitar independently.
- 12.TTW: Have class play "Hot Cross Buns" all together.
- 13.TSW: Play Hot cross buns on guitar while singing.

Assessment of Student Comprehension/Success: Informal/Aural assessment.

TSW: Play and sing "Brother John." (90% accuracy) TSW: Play and sing "Row, Row, Row Your Boat." (80% accuracy) TSW: Play "Hot Cross Buns" using guitar tablature. (70% accuracy) TSW: Play "Hot Cross Buns" while singing. (70% accuracy)

Closure/Follow- Up: TTW: Have S "break down."

- 1. Put guitar in case.
- 2. take foot stand back to box.
- 3. Place music stand on the cart.
