Objectives (TSW):

- Play a chord progression, C-G7 with no breaks for transitions.
- Accompany the song, "Shoo Fly Shoo" with the chord progression, C-G7 while strumming quarter notes.
- Create a chord chart using a chord diagram handout.
- Play the tab song, "Hot Cross Buns"
- Play Tab riff, "Louie, Louie" with recording.

Prior Knowledge and Experiences:

Opening:

- TTW: Play "Louie, Louie" by the Kingsmen.
- TTW: Review the chords, G, C, G7.
- TSW: Play and sing skip to my loo.

Procedures:

Chords:

- 1. TTW: Have S play the chord progression, C-G7
- 2. TTW: Then have S play the chord progression by row, with percussion accompaniment by T.
- 3. TTW: Have S play the progression with "Skip To My Lou" in CGM, while singing the melody. Assess by row.
- 4. TTW: Ask S to take the chord chart handout out of their folders, and fill out the chord diagrams for the three chords we know so far.
- 5. TTW: Introduce the full C chord.
- 6. TSW: S practice forming the C chord on guitar. While T monitors and corrects.
- 7. TTW: Have S echo strumming patterns on the C chord on guitar.

<u>Tablature:</u>

- 7. TTW: Review Tablature.
- 8. TTW: Show Tab ppt.
- 9. TTW: Review "Hot Cross Buns"
- 10.TSW: Play "Hot Cross Buns" using tab while singing them melody.

11.TTW: Have S play "Hot Cross Buns" on the 6th string.

- 12.TTW: Introduce "Louie, Louie"
- 13.TTW: Have S echo T in playing the riff from "Louie, Louie"
- 14.TSW: Play the tab song, "Louie, Louie" while T accompanies on guitar.

Assessment of Student Comprehension/Success: Informal/Aural assessment.

Closure/Follow- Up: TTW: Have S "break down."

- 1. Put guitar in case.
- 2. take foot stand back to box.
- 3. Place music stand on the cart.
