Objectives (TSW):

- Play a chord progression, C-G7 with percussion accompaniment.
- Accompany the song, "London Bridge" with the chord progression, C-G7 while strumming quarter notes.
- Play Tab riff, "Louie, Louie" with recording.

Prior Knowledge and Experiences:

Opening:

TTW: Play recording of "Louie, Louie" by the Kingsmen.

TTW: Review the chords, G, C, G7. TSW: Play and sing "London Bridge."

Procedures:

Chords:

- 1. TTW: Have S play the chord progression, C-G7
- 2. TTW: Have S play the progression with "London Bridge" in CGM, while singing the melody. Assess by row.
- 3. TTW: Have S practice grabbing the full C chord, and then moving to the EZ G7 chord.
- 4. TTW: Have S practice the full C-G7 with 8 beats for transitions.
- 5. TTW: Have S echo strumming patterns on muted strings on guitar, introduce the up strum.
- 6. TTW: Have S play (full) C-G7 without breaks with percussion accompaniment by T.

Tablature:

- 7. TTW: Review "Louie, Louie"
- 8. TTW: Have S echo T in playing the riff from "Louie, Louie"
- 9. TSW: Play the tab song, "Louie, Louie" while T accompanies on guitar.
- 10. TTW: Have S play riff with the recording 11. TSW: Play riff with recording by row.

Assessment of Student Comprehension/Success: Informal/Aural assessment.

Closure/Follow- Up: TTW: Have 5 "break down."
