Objectives (TSW):

- Play a chord progression, C-G7 with flute accompaniment.
- Accompany the song, "This Old Man" with the chord progression, C-G7 while strumming eighth notes on an up and down strum.
- Play Tab song, "Smoke On The Water."

Prior Knowledge and Experiences:

Opening:

TTW: Play recording of "Smoke On the Water." TTW: Review the chords, *G*, full *C*, *G*7.

Procedures:

Chords:

- 1. TTW: Have S play the chord progression, C-G7
- 2. TTW: Have each row play chord progression while T accompanies on flute.
- 3. TTW: Have S play the progression with "This Old Man" in CGM, while singing the melody. Assess by row.
- 4. TTW: Introduce the full G chord.
- 5. TSW: Practice forming the full G chord.
- 6. TTW: Have S echo T's strumming patterns on the full G chord.

<u>Tablature:</u>

- 7. TTW: Review "Louie, Louie"
- 8. TSW: Play the tab song, "Louie, Louie" while T accompanies on guitar.
- 6. TTW: Introduce "Smoke on the Water" and relate back to the recording at the beginning of class.
- 7. TSW: Practice song independently
- 8. TTW: Have class play it all together.
- 9. TTW: Have each row play song, assess.

Informal/Aural assessment.

Closure/Follow- Up: TTW: Have S "break down."
